DIAMOND WORTH 40 LACS SIEZED

POLICE STATION : NALASOPARA

DISTRICT : PALGHAR

DATE OF WORK : 25th SEPTEMBER 2015

BRIEF FACT :

On 25th July 2015 an offence was registered vide C. R. No I 270/2015 u/s 420, 34, 511 IPC. The accused namely Babulal @ Babubhai Ukaji Bhati @ Waghari, Pakaram @ Prakash @ Gopal Chelaji Rathod and Mrs. Abali, hatched criminal conspiracy with intention to cheat the complainant namely Pretak Lakshmidas Kotadiya 45yrs., by giving 655 duplicate diamonds (American Diamonds) instead of real diamond to the tune of Rs. 39,42,550/-

As the transaction was in process, a secret informer inform the Police Team of Local Crime Branch, Palghar visited the place of offence, while verifying the facts team got the facts about fake diamonds. Team searched the accused persons and seized the property - Original Diamonds, 656 Nos., and Duplicate Diamonds (American Diamonds), total amount of worth Rs. 39,42,550/- Thus the accused were nabbed red handed doing the act. During the police custody thorough interrogation of the accused discloses the another crime/offence registered at Tulinj P. S. vide C. R. No. 448/15 u/s 420, 34 I. P. C. In this crime property of Rs. 4,00,000/- was recovered.

TEN MOTOR CYCLES SEIZED, GANG OF MOTOR CYCLES THEFT ARRESTED .

BRIEF FACT :

Motor cycle thefts are a serious concern especially Vasai and Manikpur Police Station areas had seen a steep rise in thefts. A team of Vasai Police had been working on the rest incident. After continuous efforts and getting confidential information from the members of public, Vasai police successfully arrested five person involved in motor vehicle theft and detected crime no 1) 92/2015, 2)100/2015, 3) 102/2015 of Vasai Police Station. Cr no 1) 267/2015, 228/2015 of Nalasopara Police Station. Cr no 1) 76/2015, 2) 118/2015 of Arnala Police Station. Cr no 1) 523/2015,2) 559/2015 of Virar Police Station Cr no 267/2015 of Manikpur Police Station and recovered 10 motor cycles from the arrested criminals which was stolen from Vasai, Manikpur, Nalasopara, Arnala and Virar were recovered. This arrest of the gang has reduced the incidences.

GANG OF HOUSE BREAKERS ARRESTED , GOLD AND CASH RECOVERED

BRIEF FACT : On 25/04/2015 a house breaking took place at Periyar co-hous.soc.

Vasai, District Palghar. Stolen property was gold ornaments, cash and other valuable things worth Rs.7,72,500/-(Seven lakh seventy two thousand five hundred only). Investigation carried out by LCB Palghar. Information was sought and the whole area was searched for CCTV footages, secret information about accused was received through informers and verifying information trap on 02/07/2015 was laid and arrested 4 accused with gold ornaments and other valuables worth Rs.4,27,550 /-(Four lakh twenty seven thousand five fifty) recovered from accused. This house breaking was opened by conventional methods and tireless efforts of the team the case has helped in detection and prevention of house breakers as the professional gang has confessed multiple offences and are being investigated in these all offences .

DETECTION OF KIDNAPPING CASE

BRIEF FACT : On 11/12/15 11 year old boy, Shlok Pravin Bambarkar was studying at his house in Nalasopara at around 16.00 pm his mother scolded him for not studying well, the kid got revolted and decided to run away. He wrote a note and kept it at the door mentioning, "Papa and mummy I am leaving home". Reading this note his Parents approached Nalasopara Police Station. CR vide 318/2015 u/s 363 registered at Nalasopara Police Station immediately search was started by Nalasopara Police along with the police friends in the area. During the course of search one of the Police Mitra Ajay Khake, informed Police and told that boy was seen seated in a auto rickshaw and told which direction auto rickshaw went but he didn't know the exact number of auto rickshaw, then police searched whole area of direction given by Police Mitra. One Police Mitra found missing boy was sitting on foot path at Nalasopara west and convinced him to come back with him to the parents. Ultimately the boy was traced with the immediate and alert help of Police Mitras in the area. The parents and the relatives were happy and even the police friends had a sense of great satisfaction .

RECOVERY OF MISSING CHILDREN

MURDER AND KIDNAPPER NABBED. CHILD SAVED.

POLICE STATION : Nalasopara

DISTRICT : Palghar

DATE OF WORK : 20th August 2015

BRIEF FACT : Murder with kidnapping took place in Nalasopara jurisdiction, on 20/08/2015 at room number 406 a woman name - Gatkidevi Devasi was murdered and her son aged 2 years old was kidnapped by unknown persons CR vide u/s 302,364 (A),450 IPC was registered at Nalasopara police station. The accused had entered the house of the victim often pretend of delivering some goods and assaulted the pregnant lady Gatkidevi, he tried to assault her sexually. In the scuffle Gatkidevi was injured, the accused strangulated the victim and killed her and carried away the 2 years old, he has also stolen the mobile of Gatkidevi and called her husband from her mobile and demanded Rs.1.5 lakh for his son's safe release.

During the course of on investigation by technical analysis and enquiries, a trap was laid by police with the help of police friends Atul Salunke and Kayyum Patel. The boy was held hostage at an unknown place and the demand was made by calls. After a lot of negotiations the accused was traced to a Dahisar railway station and was searched by forming 8 teams. Teams relentlessly searched the area and laid a trap for the accused, Who was misguiding the complainant and had asked him to board a bus. Then he was asked to walk in rounds to ensure no one is following him. Later asked to keep the cash only at a standing bus and did not turn up. The security of the kidnapped child of being prime importance, police were discreetly keeping watch to avoid suspicion, while police friends in garb of travellers and rickshaw drivers were watching closely. After hours he turned up and was nabbed after the police friends and watchers raised alert and secured the victim the police teams rescued the kid and took in custody the accused. Police team had succeeded to nab accused Suresh Netaramand and arrest him and successfully rescued 2 year old boy within 14 hours in a neatly coordinated efforts.



RECOVERY OF MISSING CHILDREN

KDIDNAPPER NABBED , 11 YEARS KID RESCUED WITHIN 24 HRS

POLICE STATION : Waliv

DATE OF WORK : 25th JULY 2015

BRIEF FACT : On 25th July 15 an offence was registered vide C. R. No. 312/2015 u/s 363, 364 (A), 386, 342 IPC as minor boy namely Aadarsh, 11 yrs was abducted and wrongfully restrained for extortion of Rs. 3 lakhs with threat to the life of the victim .

The accused had called from the victims phone as the kid was kidnapped with his fathers mobile phone which he was using. The kid was taken away in a indica car as per the witnesses and as seen from a CCTV footage in the vicinity. After registration of offence and on technical analysis the victim and the accused were searched in areas suspected but to no avail. On tracing back the history of family and some neighbour two suspects were zeroed in and the where abouts were searched. Police friends help was sought and the victims photos along with the accused description was issued to teams. On relentless search in the railway station area one of the police friends spotted the kid a and very cleverly called the teams and helped to nab the two criminals and rescue the kid... the accused namely Chhotu @Shivaram Gangara Mourya 18, and Amit Jaiprakash Jaiswal 23.

Various teams were formed and their coordination with the police friends in rescuing and searching the victim and accused has helped to crack the case within 24 hours.



ARRESTING GANGSTERS

THREE FIREARMS SEIZED, GANG OF DACOITS ARRESTED .

BRIEF FACT :

On 14/08/2015 staff of Tulinj Police Station received an information that, at about 17.30 hrs accused namely Faizan is coming to Tulinj Toll Naka along with his associates and planned a Dacoity. It was also informed by the informant that the accused was in possession of fire arms and other deadly weapons. On information a team rushed towards Tulinj Toll Naka in plain clothes and a trap was laid.

The police officers and men used their professional skills and nabbed all 6 persons with three fire arms and three choppers. The six accused arrested all in their twenties in need of easy money had planned to loot vehicles and flee.

ARRESTING GANGSTERS

SHOOTER ARRESTED, MURDER OF MERCHANT DETECTED, THREE FIREARMS SEIZED ,

BRIEF FACT :

On 20/10/2015 murder with a firing incident took place in Tulinj Police Station area. A real estate agent and builder Sanjay Marchant was shot three rounds at, he succumbed to the bullet injuries and died in the hospital. Sanjay Marchant was a builder and role of gangsters and extortionists was suspected. Case being very sensitive it was investigated by forming various teams and also by the crime branch .

After incident Tulinj police team and local crime branch team had rounded up criminals from Chembur and Borivili, Mira-Bhayender. After a continuous effort and using professional skill local crime branch got success in a week in cracking the case and arrested 3 accused person with 3 firearms used in the offence. Detection of this the detections and arrest was a great relief as the incident has caused fear in the minds of the citizens and raised suspicions on the capability to stop such gang operation and firing incidents.



ARRESTING GANGSTERS

GANG OF ORGANIZED CRIMINALS BUSTED MCOCA APPLIED

POLICE STATION : Tulinj

DATE OF WORK : 19th October 2015

BRIEF FACT :

On 12/08/2015 a firing incidence taken place in Tulinj police station area. A known criminal Javed Ansari shot at five rounds with fire arms. As per eye witnesses three accused were involved in the firing. During course of inquiry it was revealed that accused persons were from a local gang operated by Mahendrasingh. A operation was undertaken and the accused were searched this led to the gangs of organised criminals involved in petty construction and real estate settlements business, involving land grabbing, extortion and blackmailing and the police teams collected evidence against the gang and prepare a report accordingly. A crackdown operation on major places was done and record of organised criminals was built, three gangsters were arrested and firearms are seized. The stringent section of the MCOCA ACT was applied and the gangs are broken down.... Application of MCOC to the case has impacted on criminal gang activities and helped establish order in Tulinj and Nalasopara area.
